INHALT

Your Excellency,

I am writing to you on behalf of TEP VANNY, who has been in prison since 15 August 2016 after she participated in a peaceful “Black Monday” protest. On 7 February 2018, the Supreme Court upheld Tep Vanny’s conviction of "intentional violence with aggravating circumstances" as well as her 30 month prison sentence for her peaceful participation in a protest in 2013.

Tep Vanny is a human rights defender detained on baseless charges for her peaceful activism defending. Imprisoned for simply exercising her rights to freedom of expression, peaceful assembly and association, she is a prisoner of conscience.

In light of the above I call on you to release Tep Vanny immediately and unconditionally and to drop all charges and end all criminal investigations against her.

Furthermore I call on you to publicly condemn and order an end to harassment and violence against human rights defenders, including unwarranted legal action and imprisonment.
